**HerSpace: Breast Imaging Associates ([www.herspacebreast.com](http://www.herspacebreast.com))**, founded in 2002, is Dr. Beth Deutch's vision for the way breast imaging services should be for every woman: a relaxing, warm environment offering the latest techniques and diagnostic tools with compassionate care and a timely diagnosis.

A nationally renowned and published breast imager, for the last 15 years Beth has focused her skills and radiology training exclusively on breast imaging. She has interpreted over 100,000 mammograms and performed thousands of imaging-guided needle breast biopsies. Her list of over 300 referring physicians is testimony to her stature among the Monmouth medical community as the area's leading breast imager.

Beth was the first radiologist in New Jersey certified to read digital mammography and credentialed by the American College of Radiology in stereotactic and ultrasound-guided needle breast biopsy. *HerSpace* is among the first specialty radiology practices in the nation to offer CAD (Computer Aided Diagnosis) with full-field digital mammography.

Dr. Deutch left New York's highly regarded Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in 1993 to build a state-of-the-art breast-imaging program at the Jacqueline M. Wilentz Comprehensive Breast Center at Monmouth Medical Center. First as

director of breast imaging and then as medical director, Dr. Deutch spent the next eight years developing what is now regarded as one of New Jersey's premier breast imaging practices. It is also among the state's busiest facilities. Prior to her arrival at the Wilentz Center, the facility processed only 3,000 mammograms. By 2001, Beth and her staff were reading and interpreting upwards of 30,000 studies a year.

One of Dr. Deutch's early clinical positions was as assistant attending radiologist at the Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center where she started the world-famous cancer hospital's breast MRI program and helped pioneer stereotactic breast biopsy. She completed her residency in diagnostic radiology and fellowship in breast imaging at The Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania, and before that spent her internship in Internal Medicine at St. Vincent's Hospital in NYC. She is a graduate of Brown University and The Johns Hopkins School of Medicine.

Dr. Deutch's dedication to her profession is as evident in her academic and publishing accomplishments as it is in her clinical practice. She served as Instructor at The University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine and Assistant Professor of Radiology at Cornell University Medical College and at Sloan-Kettering Memorial Hospital in New York City. For over a decade she has been an active member of The Radiological Society of North America, the American College of Radiology, the American Association of Women Radiologists and the Society of Breast Imaging. She has published more than a dozen articles and case reports in professional journals and continues to lecture at leading hospitals and medical institutions. She is a mammography reviewer for The American College of Radiology.

Dr. Deutch's busy professional life is happily grounded by her three children - Simon, Noah and Charlotte - and husband Larry.
